Meeting started at 4:08 p.m.

Motion Mark Puetz, Second John McLeod to approve the October 12, 2010 minutes as read.
Motion approved and carried.

Mayor Sebert gave the Committee an overview of the New Land Designation Ordinance, noting some areas of concern due to the wording of the Ordinance.

The Committee discussed the following items concerning the lake and the new ordinance;

- Public access lots currently maintained & utilized only by homeowner next to access lot
- Need to explore new funding options
- Donation of new tree's if the need arises
- Adopt an Access Area Program and more volunteer help for all areas of Lake clean up
- Explore watershed programs
- Bring high use areas (i.e. Public Beach) up to a high standard of maintenance and use
- Development of a master plan for the Lake area

The Committee would like to extend a special Thank You to Troy Helleloid for all the time he has dedicated in removing and storing the Solar Bee from Lake Mitchell for the winter; Moving the new handicap fishing dock to shore for the winter and pulling all boat lifts out of Lake Mitchell for the winter.

Joe Kippes informed the Committee that Dave Allen had contacted him regarding placing cedar tree structures in the lake for fish habitat. After considerable discussion the Committee would like Dave Allen to consult Andy Petersen the Game, Fish & Parks Conservation Officer on placing tree structures in the lake. Also, the Committee would like to have a map of the lake showing where there are currently fish habitat structures and where future ones would be placed.

Greg McCurry advised the Committee he will be sending out requests for agenda items sooner and would like Committee members to submit requested agenda items to him as soon as possible.

The Committee would like to extend a special Thank You to McLeods Printing and John McLeod for printing the Adopt an Access Area brochure.

Dusty Rodiek presented to the Committee a Lake Mitchell Park Area Proposals handout for their review.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 4:55 p.m., noting the next meeting date for the Lake Mitchell Advisory Committee to be December 14, 2010 at the Mitchell Recreation Center Conference Room.
