Meeting was called to order by Bob Everson, President at 12:02 p.m.

New Park, Recreation and Forestry Director Dusty Rodiek introduced himself to the Board and asked for an update on the Pepsi Cola Soccer Complex as well as information on the Public Capital Input Meeting on June 8<sup>th</sup>.

Board President Everson gave an outline of the purpose of the Public Capital Input Meeting, what potential associations will attend and a general idea of what Capital Projects they may present. President Everson gave a brief history into the concept, site choosing, funding and construction of the Pepsi Cola Soccer Complex.

Discussion was held on the section of land located on the corner of 8<sup>th</sup> and the Bypass and the need to get a current master plan put together as well as plans for the old soccer fields.

Council President Jeff Smith informed the Board that there would be a discussion on the plans for a Community Center at the Monday, June 7<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting. Mr. Smith informed the Board that no plans have been drawn up and the City will first need to look at the feasibility of a Community Center located at DWU, with the land and building being owned by the City and operated by the City, with a portion of the facility being leased to DWU and Avera Queen of Peace.
