Meeting started at 3:08 p.m.

Motion Troy Helleloid, Second Greg McCurry to approve the August 9, 2011 Minutes as read.
Motion approved and carried.

Boat ride around Lake to inspect completed, on-going and future projects of 2011 and beyond:

- * Sportsman's boat ramp – Request by Chad VanLaecken for barge storage in parking lot during winter. After a lengthy discussion, Motion Bob Sebert, Second John McLeod to make a recommendation to City Council to open up the Sportsman's boat ramp east parking lot for barge storage during the winter following the current boat storage guidelines with a fee of \$100.00 per unit. Motion approved and carried.
- * Sandy Beach – Potential future improvements; larger beach area, new rip rap, single entry/exit road, parking lot, jetties with potential boat docking area
- * West Boat Launch Area – Future rip rap in sandy area for shore stabilization
- * New handicap fishing pier – Adopted by SkillsUSA, new restroom facility being installed
- * Ohlman/South Harmon Access Area – Adopted by Wedgewood Estates who recently held a cleanup day and volunteers painted the shelter, straightened and secured the bbq grill and cleaned up the entire access area
- * Access area next to Endorf's – Rip rap along access area needed to stabilize shoreline
- * Shoreline between Sportsman's Club & Day Camp - Greg McCurry informed the Committee that City Council has approved the improvement plan for road and shore stabilization between the Sportsman's Club and Day Camp.
- * Sportsman's Boat Ramp/Sportsman's Club – Dusty Rodiek informed the Committee the Archeological survey came back with good recommendations and will now be forwarded to State Historical Society for approval and a grant will be applied for in June 2012
- * Campground – Park Explorers cleaned up and helped clear trees from boat dock area, potential overnight boat storage for campers discussed, completed rip rap projected reviewed
- * Shoreline between Spillway & Kibbee Park – Greg McCurry informed the Committee funds be approved for use to improve lake visibility from Highway and shoreline stabilization

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 4:20 p.m., noting the next meeting of the Lake Advisory Committee to be October 11, 2011 at 4:00 p.m., at the Mitchell Recreation Center.
