Explanation/Background of Agenda Item Requested:

The proposed agreement will provides design and bidding services for the Livesay Lane Utility Improvements project. See attached map for project location.

The Livesay Lane Utility Improvements proposes to install storm water and sanitary sewer connections to a future development. A water main will also be installed from Anthony Avenue to the south to provide a loop line to improve water quality. The storm water line will provide the potential of collecting storm water along Anthony Avenue which experiences periods of standing water in ditches. The storm water line will also provide a connection point to future Michael Avenue and further north. A storm water settling basin will be utilized south of North Harmon Drive just before discharging to the lake to promote better water quality. Anthony Avenue is currently served by septic tanks and is in City limits. This project will provide gravity sanitary sewer service to future developments located north of Anthony Avenue. The proposal from IDG also includes assisting in securing SRF funding for the project. A portion of the costs associated with the project may be recouped through connection fees.

Staff recommends City Council approval of the attached agreement with Infrastructure Design Group, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$59,242.00 for the Livesay Lane Utility Improvement project.
