The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT), in conjunction with the City of Mitchell and Davison County, will hold an informal, open house style public meeting to discuss and receive public input on the development of the Mitchell Area Master Transportation Plan (MTP). The MTP will be a long-range (20 year) plan to address existing and future multimodal transportation issues and needs in the Mitchell area. The study is in the initial stages and the Study Team is seeking input to help guide priorities and identify transportation issues and needs.

Between 6:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m., members of the Study Team will be available with displays to discuss transportation issues in the Mitchell area and answer your questions. During this time, you will also have the opportunity to present written comments. A virtual component of the open house will also be available on the study website, starting the day of the in-person public meeting and extending through February 11, 2022.

A transportation survey is available on the study website until February 11, 2022 to help gather thoughts on the current transportation system, identify future needs, and indicate priorities for future improvements.
