Explanation/Background of Agenda Item Requested:

This is a request to accept \$53,000 in grant funds to expand the skate park with concrete features at Dry Run Creek Park. We have worked with the local skateboarders and bicyclists to raise an additional \$22,119 for a total match of \$75,119 or 61% of the total project cost of \$123,000.
